

Things to bring if you are volunteering in New Orleans January - April

As you are packing, we just wanted to offer some advice.

~YOU ARE GOING TO BE DOWN HERE IN OUR WINTER/SPRING. Some days it's winter, some days it's spring. It even gets cold (yes, cold). You'll want layers for when it's winter in the morning and spring in the afternoon as you may be working inside, outside, or both. You may be really glad you brought a hat and a coat. Check the weather for New Orleans before you leave, but expect the unexpected.

~DON'T WEAR YOUR BEST CLOTHES. Things get messy around here. Wear stuff that you don't mind getting dirty, paint splattered, or even destroyed. If it's expensive and/or a favorite, don't wear it on site.

~WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS. Our facilities are pretty secure, but we have some sneaky people in this town. Also, laptops have a bad habit of falling from top bunks. The smaller iPads get, the more likely they are to get stepped on. Jewelry magically disappears around here. We could go on. If you don't bring it, you can't lose it.

~PLEASE DON'T FORGET TO BRING a pillow, blankets or a sleeping bag, your towel (never travel without your towel), flip flops for walking to and from the showers, your prescription meds, your cell phone charger, etc.

~SAFETY FIRST. Please make sure you bring a pair of good, sturdy shoes to wear on site. Work boots are best, but most thick soled, closed toed shoes are fine. As for the shorts issue, there are some projects where you cannot wear shorts, but most of the time that's up to you. Definitely bring your own water bottle and make sure it is clearly labeled with your name. We provide the necessary personal protection equipment such as safety glasses, work gloves, etc, but they've usually seen better days so we strongly encourage you to bring your own; especially safety glasses. You should bring your own safety glasses. You're going to get tired of hearing the words "safety glasses."
